In order to provide these individuals with additional support we have formed a High Risk Support team. The team consists of Service Coordinators, Clinicians, Day Hab and Residential Staff and Family Support Providers. Each team member has extensive experience and training assisting individuals with High Risk needs.

Community Living

We will assist you in finding a residential opportunity that is right for you.

Vocational & Day Services

We will help you to find challenging employment, fulfilling volunteer opportunities, and/or a day program individually designed to promote personal independence and community inclusion through activities that stimulate both the mind and body.

Education

We will aid you in navigating the educational system to help you achieve your fullest potential.

Recreation & Leisure Opportunities

We will help you to identify and pursue leisure and social activities that are of interest to you.

Benefits & Entitlements

We will help you to determine benefits you may be entitled to and assist with completing the necessary paperwork to receive and maintain those benefits.
